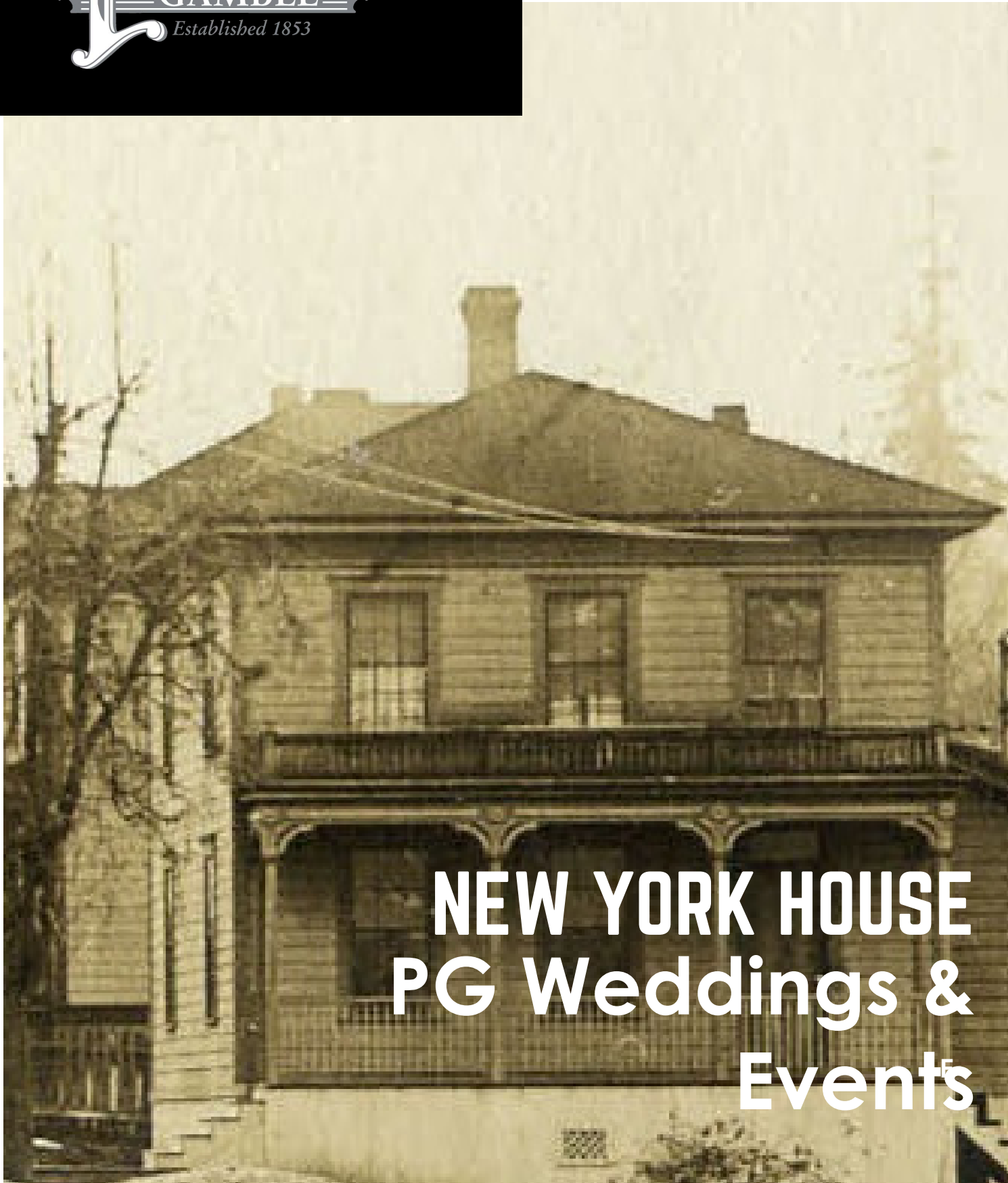

NEW YORK HOUSE

HISTORY

This building was home to the resident physician in Port Gamble as early as 1860(the earliest year this house could have been constructed). It is one of a few houses erected by employees, who typically embellished the house a little more than other housing which explains the turn-style pilasters and transoms, which set the house apart from other remaining homes. The house was the hospital by 1881 and was used as such until 1929 when a hospital built closer to the mill was constructed. It was used as a private residence from 1929-2000 and is now used as a commercial space.

REPORTED ACTIVITY

From a historical standpoint, since this house belonged to the resident doctor's and also served as the town/mill hospital for many years, there were many visitors to this residence with sickness and injuries suffered at the mill. There seems to be activity all over this house.

One frequent report is "someone" will tell patrons or investigators to "get out". This someone is believed to be the original doctor, N.W. Lane.

There are also countless reports of a little happy girl throughout the house, but she is mostly seen at the top of the stairs. Reports show that she pulls on your pant leg to get your attention or may even speak. Audio evidence concludes that her voice is mostly EVP.

There are many other reports of shadowy figures upstairs, in the parlor, and the kitchen (where we believe surgeries took place).
